



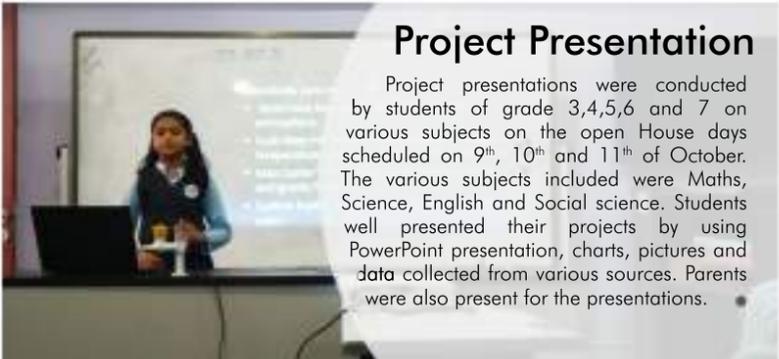
## Fun And Fitness Day
