

Circular No 06/ 22-23 24 June 2022

Dear family,

This is to inform you that the School Election for the year 2022-23 has been declared and will take place on Friday 1 July 2022. The students from grade 4 to 10 are eligible to cast their votes. Please note that

- 1) The Election and the result declaration will be on Friday 1 July 2022.
- 2) The following positions for which the election is conducted
 - a) Grade Prefect (Only for Grade 5-10)
 - b) Arts Minister (Grade 8-10)
 - c) Sports Minister (Grade 8-10)
 - d) Health Minister (Grade 8-10)
 - e) School Head Boy (Grade 9&10)
 - f) School Head Girl (Grade 9&10)
- 3) Last day of nomination is Monday 27 June 2022 by 3 pm. Late submission and incomplete nominations will be rejected.
- 4) Nominations without the consent of parents or the grade in charge will not be accepted.
- 5) The nomination will be accepted only after a successful interview for the candidates with the Election Committee.
- 6) The Election Commission has the power to reject the nomination if finds any discipline issues or misbehaviour during the election days including the campaign.
- 7) The complete election and result procedures will be done through a digital platform developed by the school.
- 8) During the campaign the candidates or their supporters must strictly abstain from offering any sop, threatening, bullying, etc.
- 9) Election posters are permitted only on soft boards designated by the Election Commission.
- 10) The school walls or classroom boards cannot be used for any campaign posters.
- 11) Entering other classes for the campaign is permitted only with the permission of the teacher in charge.
- 12) The final result will be based on the majority of the votes polled against the candidate, and that should be wholeheartedly agreed by all candidates in the fray.
- 13) Candidates are expected to continue supporting the elected leaders and the school although they could not succeed in the election.
