Environment Day




Our students of Ace Department participated in Model SoD Zest (season 2) Conducted by The Model School, Abu Dhabi.









NELSON MANDELA DAY

We observed Nelson Mandela Day on JULY 18th Monday . Students did their part well to make the day meaningful with their speeches ,quotes and posters.







Number Sense Activity












International Tiger Day



The Yellow Colour Day






