GEOMETRIC DESIGNS & PATTERNS DAY

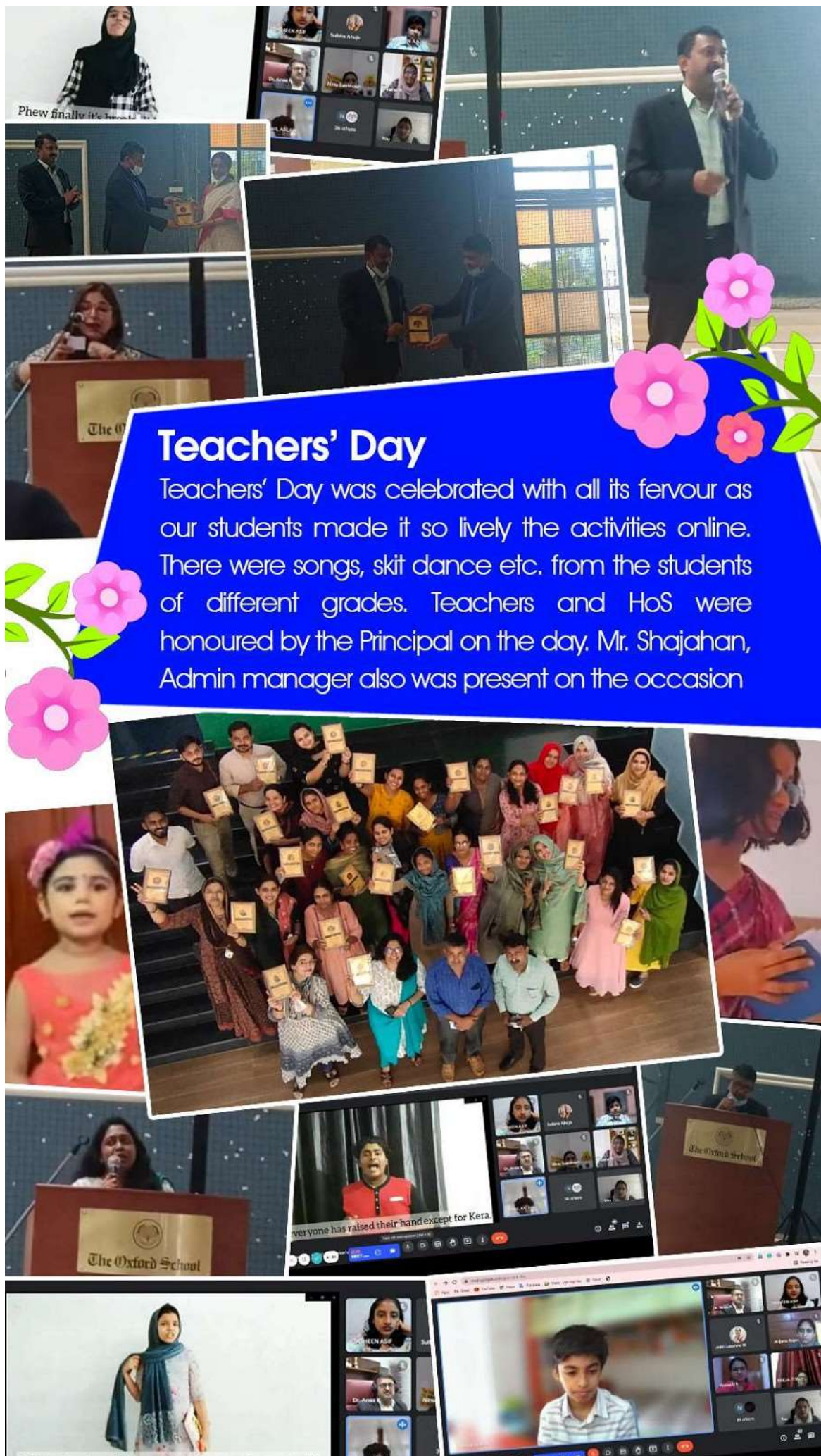

Knowledgepedia

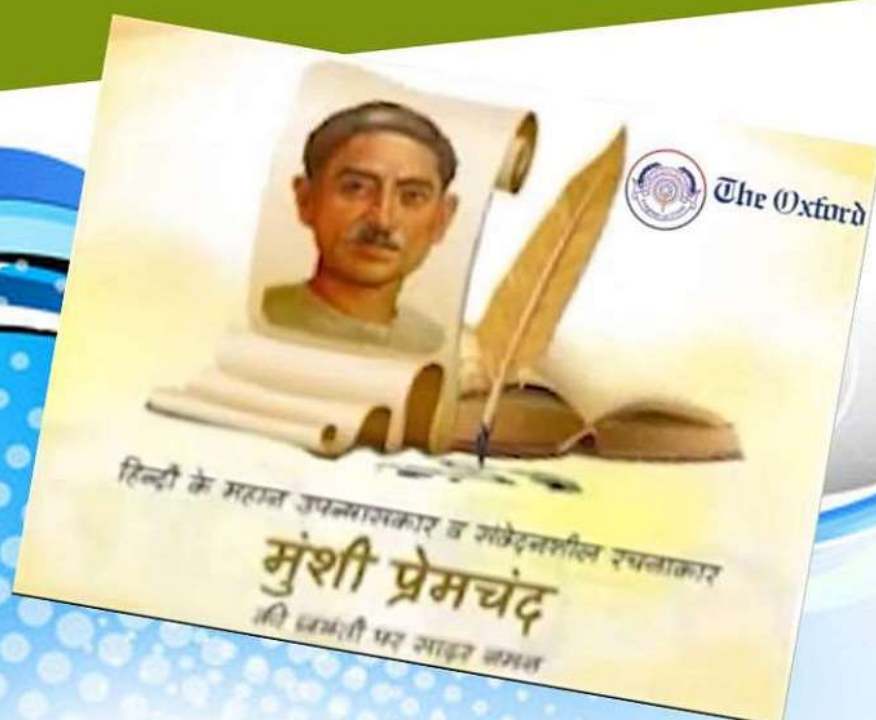

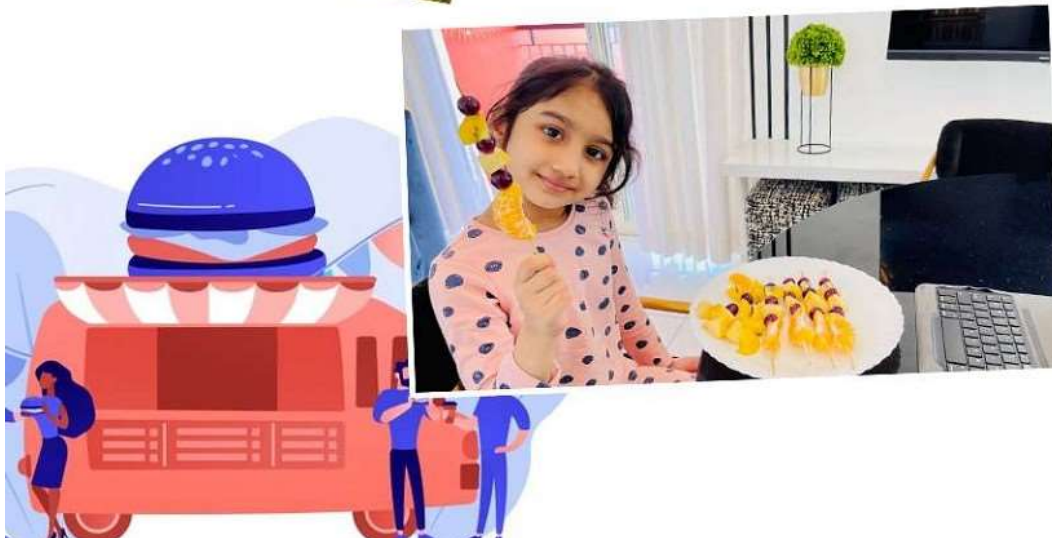
FOOD FEST

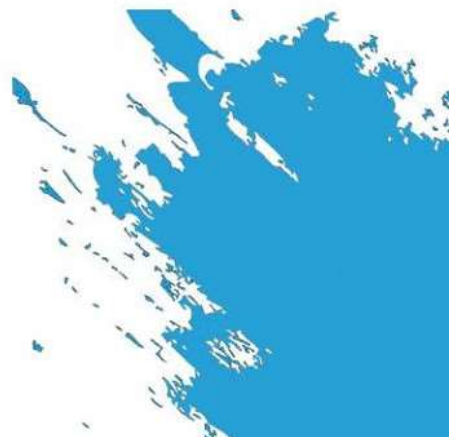
