Children were in different shades of Brown Colour attire and looked beautiful.



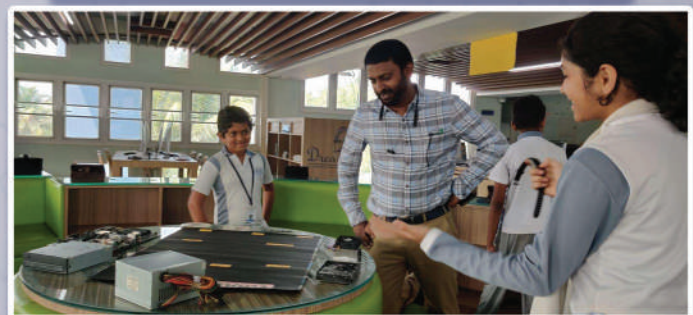
TINY TOTS -BLUE DAY CELEBRATION

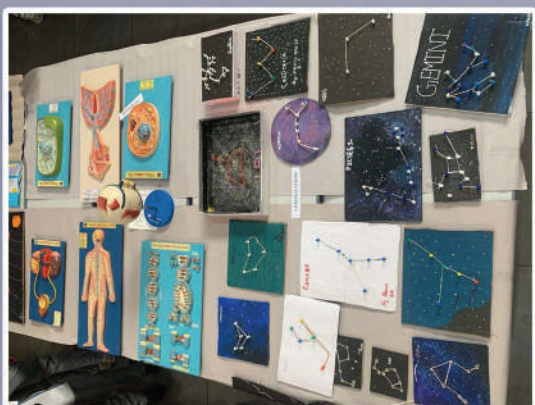
EDUBITION

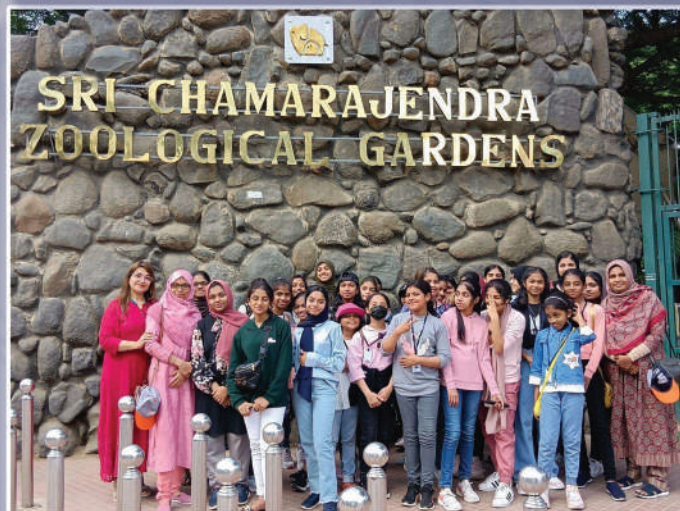
THANK YOU CARD

CHILDREN'S DAY



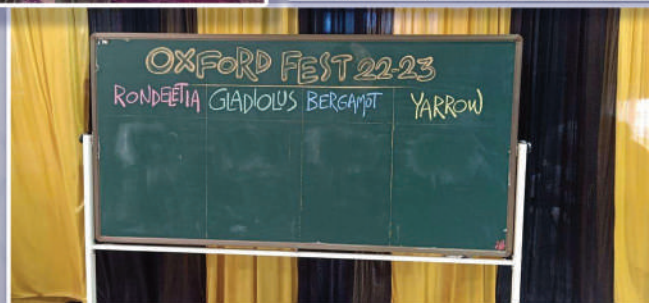

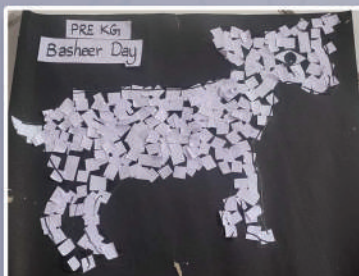
STREET PLAY ON BASHEER DAY

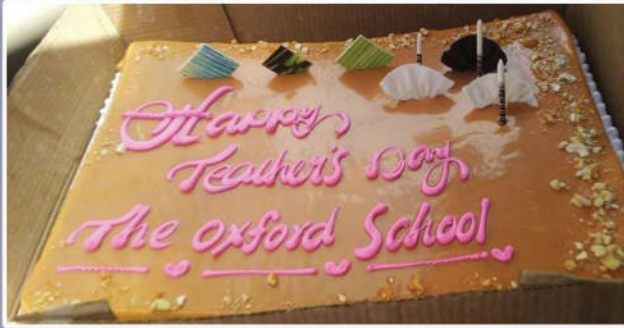
ONAM CELEBRATIONS

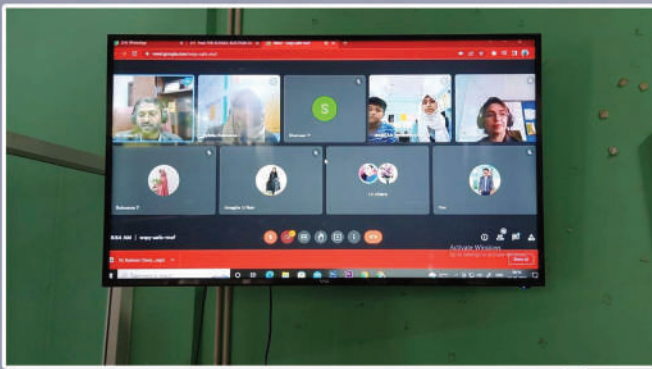
MALABAR BOTANICAL GARDEN

They also donated some saplings to school.



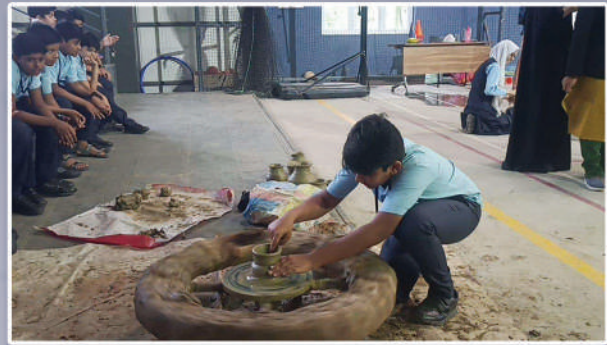
CLUB INAUGURATION

HEALTHY FOOD V/S JUNK FOOD

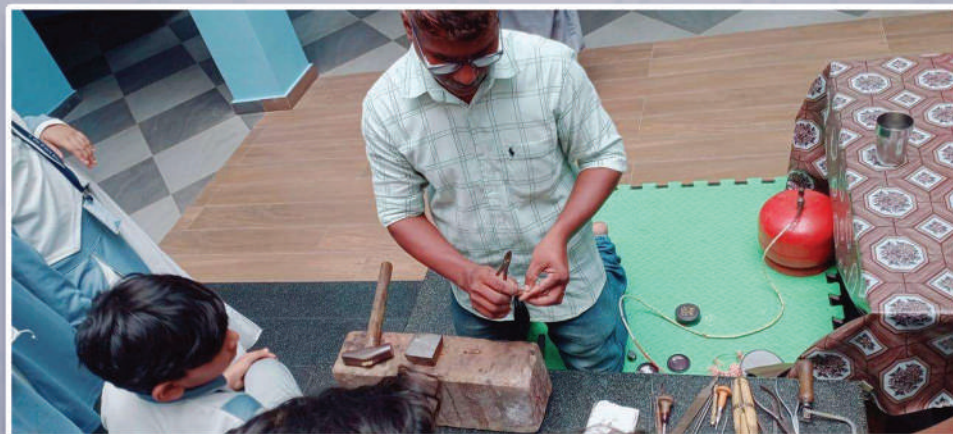


Healthy Vs Junk food. It is not easy to teach them the difference between healthy and junk food, but it was very interesting to ask them to prepare those items in class.

Constantly being focused can help you focus and keep calm in high-pressure situations.



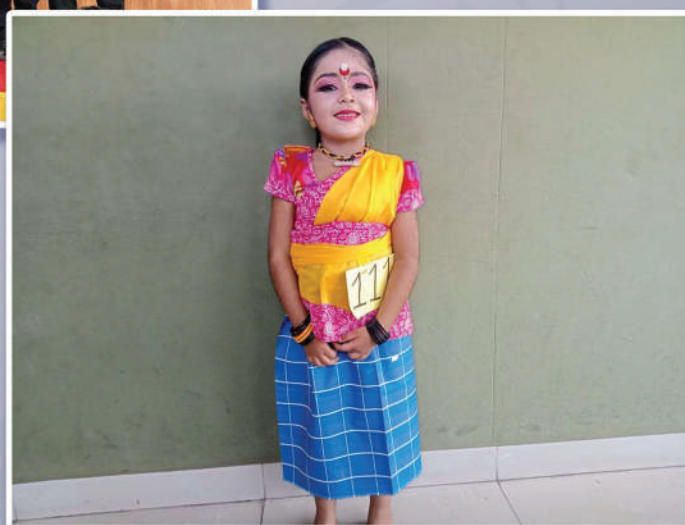
THE ROLLING SUCCESS!
