



Dear Family, Greetings from The Oxford School!!

The school conducted one parent orientation session for all classes and most of the parents attended the same. I hereby send you the important points discussed in the orientation

- The School has been upgraded till Plus2 and the admission to Plus1 (Science & commerce) is open for the coming academic year. We always give preference to the siblings and relatives of our own existing students.
- 2. The school will reopen on Monday 5th June 2023 for tiny Tots to Grade 1.
- 3. School Timing: 9.00 am to 2.10 pm

4. Monday 5th June

Tiny Tots- Parents should drop children at 10 am, be with them and pick them by 11 am

FS1- Parents should drop at 10 am and the school bus will pick them back by 12.30 pm

If parents need to pick their children, that to be done only by 1 pm. (after lunch, snack should be carried)

FS2 and G1- School bus will bring the students at 9 am and return at 12.30 pm after lunch. (Snack should be carried)

- 5. Tiny tots to FS2 A pair of extra dress to be kept at school, that should be well wrapped/packed and labelled on it.
- 6. Late reporting and parent pick up during the school hours to be avoided from the parents' side. Parent pick up will be allowed if informed before 12 pm, which is only on emergency situation with valid reason.
- 7. Parents need to use **BM School Diary App** to get all Circulars, Attendance, Home Assignments, Report Cards etc.
- 8. Student's Planner/ School Diary to be used for leave marking, assignment tracking etc.
- 9. School uniform includes hair style, proper shoes, inserting shirt, wearing belt, ID card etc.
- 10. Birth Day cakes, Expensive Ornaments etc. to be avoided.
- 11. School is not responsible for any WhatsApp group created by students or parents.
- 12. school will send mails/ Diary App notifications rather than WhatsApp Messages
- 13. School encourages the usage of Mangahigh for Maths (Grade1), A-Z (FS2 &1) for English at home.
- 14. Books and uniform must be collected as soon as possible
- 15. Grade in charges, Subject teachers, Drivers and Bus Assistants passed their mobile numbers with all parents in the meeting
