Please go through the details of activities and its requirements.

- Book fair Students are expected to bring books like Fiction, nonfiction, etc to school, which will be showcased in the library. Students must label their name and class on the books they prefer to showcase; these books can be taken to the class library thereafter if they wish.
- Book Donation Drive- We encourage all students/staff/members to contribute un used note books (in good condition) to be donated to underprivileged children or the fictions to local libraries. Let's share the joy of reading with others and make a difference in their lives.
- Visit your local library: Libraries are a great place to find books, magazines, and other reading materials. Children can also participate in library programs and events if they host any (Panchayat Libraries visit Grades 4,5 & 6)
- Create a Book Trailer: Students can create book trailers for the books that they have read. This is a great way to promote books and to get other students interested in reading them. Grade 8,9 & 10 (Prepare video and share it in the folder with the Grade in charge.
- Guest Author Talk: We are thrilled to visit renowned author M.T. Vasudevan Nair.
- Book Talk: students can give book talks about the that books they have read. This is similar to a book review, but it is more informal and interactive. Students can share their favourite parts of the book, why they liked it, and what they think other students might like. Which will be done in the school assembly.
- Storytelling Sessions inside the library: Engage in interactive storytelling sessions conducted by our experienced librarian. She will bring stories to life, fostering imagination and a love for storytelling. (Grade 2-4)
- Peer Reading: Reading is a great way to help & develop a love of reading. Students
 can read to their friend group or volunteer to read to the whole class to showcase
 their reading skills. (Library hours Grade 5-7)
- Reading Corners: Relax and delve into the world of literature at our dedicated reading corners. We will provide class library arrangements and students shall bring a wide range of books to explore. Take a break from your regular routine and immerse yourself in captivating stories (Grade 2-10)
