In celebration of World Environment Day, June 5, 2025, the social and welfare club of The Oxford School is initiating a project for the students of Grades 3-12 entitled "*Meet My Green World*" to foster environmental awareness and responsibility among our society.

1. **Objective:** Encourage each student to plant and nurture a sapling at home and produce something from the garden or a self-plant pot
2. Promoting greenery and understanding the importance of plants in our ecosystem.

Participation: We request interested students to enroll their names in the Grade Incharge before 21/06/25. Based on a small attitude test, the qualified students will receive the Observation Ticket for contesting for the award.

Program Details:

- Plant a sapling of choice at home - A kitchen garden, Front yard or backyard, Hanging pot, Window sill, Terrace farming etc
- Maintain a self-weekly journal documenting the growth and care of the plant apart from the Observation ticket.
- Share photographs of the planting process and the plant's progress over a month.

Assessment:

1. Students should submit their observation ticket on every submission date
2. Photographs, Videos must be sent based on the instructions
3. Must attend the online video meetings at the instructional time
4. The result will be based on the credits given in the Observation Ticket and Analysis during the different stages of assessment.

This initiative aims to instill a sense of responsibility towards nature and provide a hands-on learning experience about plant life and environmental conservation.
